History 1923 started by a break away group from Heaton Moor Rugby Club. 1st President was Henry Fildes Liberal MP for Stockport. Originally called Davenport Rugby Club and got permission from the Bromley Davenports of Capesthorne to use their family emblem of the Felon's Head.

1st premises were in Grange Road and moved to Hanley Road after the war. Then in 1964 Stockport B.C bought the land for housing and they moved to Headlands Road. They named it the Memorial Ground as they had lost 11 members in the 2nd World War.

Teams - From 1967 the Glengarth Sevens raised money for the next 21 years for Glengarth House, a home for disabled children in Marple. 7 a side gave way to League Rugby in the mid 1980s. In 1992 changed its name to Stockport RUFC

There are 3 Senior VXs, 1 Any Age and 1 Veterans. 7 boys' team, 7 12 and under mixed teams and 4 Women & girls.

Fees

The Standard Senior Club players pay £120 p.a and Student players pay £90

Junior members pay £20 and Senior social members £40

A senior Club season ticket is £40

The Club House provides excellent facilities and is available for hire for private parties and corporate events.

Founded in 1860 as Manchester Football Club, one of the first Rugby Union clubs in the world
